

Webber BBQ – Instructions

Note – All cleaning spray, equipment and sponges are kept in the middle kitchen drawer. BBQ utensils are hanging off the hook on the BBQ.

1. Before you start cooking, please check there is a foil drip tray placed under the grill to catch the grease and oil. Spare trays are kept in the kitchen drawer.
2. After you finish cooking, disconnect your gas tank; consult your owner's manual (located in the bottom drawer in the common lounge kitchen) for directions on your specific model.
3. Next, while the surfaces are still hot, brush the grates to remove any food debris (brush is hanging on the BBQ hook), then spray your grate cleaner and let it settle for 30 seconds. After, scrub the grates with the abrasive side of a sponge, rinse with water and set aside for drying.
4. Wipe down the grill, drip tray and bottom tray: use a brush when needed. Be careful not to splash water onto the burner tubes.
5. Make sure your barbecue dries thoroughly before reassembling your barbecue and finishing your grates with a non-stick spray.
6. Put the cover back on the BBQ. **IMPORTANT** – there are Velcro ties at the bottom of the cover, these must be stuck together otherwise the cover will blow off in the wind.
